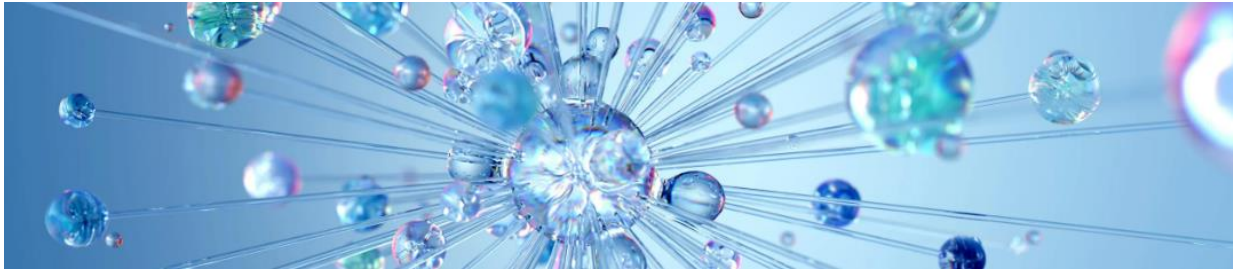


Call for Faculty Participants

Curious to explore the impact of using Gen AI tools on Teaching and Learning outcomes? Apply NOW to Join us...



Funded by the SUNY Innovative Instruction Technology Grants (IITG) Program, and aligned with SUNY's initiative to advance artificial intelligence (AI) literacy, the **Examining the Usability and Efficacy of GenAI Tools** project is recruiting 50 faculty across seven SUNY campuses to explore how pro versions of ChatGPT, Perplexity, Gemini and Claude can be used to design meaningful learning experiences, and to examine their impact on teaching and learning outcomes.

In Fall 2025, Faculty participants will:

- **Receive guidance and free access to** pro versions of two AI tools (ChatGPT, Claude, Gemini, or Perplexity).
- Engage in a **virtual orientation** in October and **training** throughout the fall and spring terms.
- **Develop either an AI Chatbot/mentor** or an AI-infused Capstone Experience or a series of two AI-infused assignments that promote AI literacy and a disciplinary outcome of their choice

In Spring 2026, Faculty participants will:

- **Recruit up to 20 students as participants** to complete the assignments using pro versions of two AI tools assigned to you.
- **Collaborate with two student partners** to refine AI-infused assignments, implement the AI-infused experiences and help gather data.
- Receive a **\$500 stipend** on completion of all tasks
