Violent Restraint Orders for Non-Psych Units

New BestPractice Advisories and SmartText



Overview of Feature / Changes

Effective Monday September 23, 2019, two new **BestPractice Advisories (BPA)** and a **SmartText** (note template) are available to help satisfy documentation requirements outlined in **Policy CM R-13 Restraints Standards for Non-Psych Units**. Per policy, a **face-to-face evaluation** must be completed and documented **within 60 minutes of initiating the intervention and placing the restraint order**. **In order to satisfy the BPA, providers must use the specific SmartText as described below.**

Initial BPA for Provider Compliance

Upon signing any of the NUR970 Restraints-Behavioral Health orders listed below, this BPA will fire as a reminder to providers to **complete a face-to-face evaluation and documentation within 30-40 minutes of placing the order**. Click **Accept**. *Only use the Follow Up Action Taken option if you've completed the evaluation and required documentation.*

- Restraints-Behavioral Health (Under Age 9) [NUR970]
- Restraints-Behavioral Health (Adult) [NUR970A]
- Restraints-Behavioral Health (Age 9-17) [NUR970B]


Follow-Up (Secondary) BPA for Provider Compliance

This BPA will fire **after 30 minutes has passed** since the NUR970 order was signed to notify providers that a face-to-face note **HAS NOT been written** using the specific SmartText (note template). **Use the "Click here" hyperlink to quickly open a blank note where a provider can pull in the appropriate note template. See next page for details.** If the specific note template is not used, the BPA will not be satisfied and will continue to fire.

Post Restraint Face-to-Face Note Template (SmartText)

In a blank note, type **.postrest** and select the Post Restraint Face-to-Face option **[.POSTRESTRAINTF2F]**. Complete the note using the **F2** key to navigate through the smart elements. Sign when finished.

Completion of this specific note template will satisfy the BPA.
