Overview of Feature / Changes

The following information highlights system changes Inpatient Providers can expect with the 2019 Fall Epic Upgrade.



Interface Updates

To simplify the look and feel of Hyperspace and to give more room to a user's main activities, we've made some changes:

- Patient Header no longer appears as a horizontal bar.
- Storyboard Now appears as a vertical bar to review a patient's story quickly (Bulletin).
- Summary Activity In one summary activity, review a patient's intake and output, results and medications, and a chronological list of events from the patient's stay.
- Navigators Users can drag and drop sections within the same topic or between topics or move topics around, including into other panes.

Patient Lists

Patient lists now appear the same even when there are more than 50 patients in the list. Rows are now always set to a height of 3 lines. If a column contains more information than can appear at once, hover to see the contents in a tooltip.

To help prevent mix-ups, patients with similar last or first names, or similar-sounding names, appear in bold and italics.

Event Log

Jump around the Event Log to follow-up on specific documentation or find out what happened to a patient at a specific moment. Jump to different dates in Event Log.

Notes Activity

Change the layout of the notes in the note list, within a pre-determined set of layouts.

The notes personalization settings have a new look to make them easier to use. Click and drag speed buttons to re-order them.

▲ Chart Review

Lifetime is a new activity displaying the patient's basic medical history. Presented as a quick button in Chart Review, the activity allows you to zoom in on specific time periods, get additional details from descriptive hover bubbles, and quickly view a detailed report.

Sex-Specific Macro Settings

The Sex field in the Macro Selection window provides a tooltip for help users understand how the sex setting will affect which patients the Macro applies to. Comprehensive macros only apply to patients with incongruent sex and gender data.

Personalize Important Activity Tabs

Use the wrench or right-click on an activity tab to mark it as important. Tabs will appear with larger font, a color band, and an icon. Users can also choose a specific color.




Storyboard Basics
