EPIC SYSTEM UPDATE

Overview of Feature / Changes

Effective Monday November 4, 2019. Upstate will implement the first phase of screening tools and workflows in Epic to monitor patients at risk for substance use disorder. Standardized tools within Epic allow a systematized collection of vital information regarding a patient's risk of substance use disorder or opioid management. Information has traditionally been stored in separate components within the chart. Integrating access to prior screenings and substance related problems will produce the best outcomes and most effective approach for supporting our patients. New features will be implemented to help improve access to information and quality of treatment.

- Standardized substance abuse screening for all patients aged 11 years and older (Peds, ages 11-19 / Adults, ages 19+)
 - In the event a patient is identified as at risk for substance abuse based on the Substance Use
 Disorder screening, a BPA will trigger with a consult or referral order to Social Work. This workflow will be seen in Ambulatory clinics, the Emergency Departments and Inpatient Hospital contexts.
- New York State Department of Health Prescription Drug Monitoring Program (PDMP) BestPractice Advisory (BPA)
 - The BPA launches an integrated PDMP within Epic and allows documentation of the PDMP review status in the patient's chart.
- **Standardized Pain Agreements** [F84067] for patients with long-term controlled prescriptions that can be signed by the patient.
- Patients in Ambulatory, Inpatient, and Emergency contexts will receive the New York State Office of Alcoholism and Substance Abuse Services (OASAS) handout with their After Visit Summary if:
 - The patient has not been screened for substance use and is aged 10 years or older.
 - The patient has a positive screening for substance use.
