# **Overview of Feature / Changes**

Effective Tuesday January 7, 2020, new workflows will be implemented in Epic to support the New York State (NYS) Department of Health (DOH) directive to offer the Sexual Assault Bill of Rights to any patient who reports sexual assault and accepts the document upon offer. Nurses, Social Workers, and Providers in all contexts (Ambulatory, Inpatient, and Emergency) will participate in the various aspects of this documentation and workflow in Epic.
