

## EPIC SYSTEM UPDATE

### Overview of Feature / Changes

**Effective Tuesday January 7, 2020**, new workflows will be implemented in Epic to support the **New York State (NYS) Department of Health (DOH)** directive to offer the **Sexual Assault Bill of Rights** to any patient who reports sexual assault and accepts the document upon offer. **Nurses, Social Workers, and Providers** in all contexts (**Ambulatory, Inpatient, and Emergency**) will participate in the various aspects of this documentation and workflow in Epic.
