EPIC SYSTEM UPDATE

Overview of Feature / Changes

Effective Tuesday February 4, 2020, several changes will be implemented in Epic to improve and streamline infection and isolation management for patients. Currently the Infection / Isolation mismatch BestPractice Advisory (BPA) is misfiring due to the number of Isolation statuses available in Epic, and only one status is allowed at a time which requires that providers and Infection Prevention staff find the right combination isolation status to meet necessary precautions.

What's Chanaina?

Isolation Orders

- o 23 Isolation orders have been reduced to 5 for more **simplified ordering**.
 - Combination Isolation orders such as Droplet and Airborne Isolation [ISO10] or Contact and Droplet and Airborne Isolation [ISO11] orders will no longer be available.
 - The following 5 Isolation orders remain:
 - Airborne Isolation [ISO4]
 - Contact Isolation [ISO1]
 - Contact Plus Isolation [ISO9]
 - Droplet Isolation [ISO2]
 - Modified Pulmonary Contact Isolation [ISO18]
- The **Request for Infection and/or Isolation Update order** remains unchanged. Providers can use this order to communicate a request for an Infection and or Isolation update to Infection Prevention staff.

Isolation Status

- Isolation orders drive Isolation status which appears in Storyboard.
- Multiple isolation statuses are allowed to achieve the correct combination of isolations. In turn, this will reduce confusion and allow the Infection / Isolation mismatch BPA to fire correctly.
- Nursing and Infection Prevention staff can manually update Isolation Status in Storyboard as needed prior to an Isolation order being placed in the system. This helps to ensure that appropriate precautions are taken as soon as possible.
- Infection/Isolation Mismatch BestPractice Advisory (BPA)
 - The BPA exhibits updated behavior to match newly streamlined Isolation orders.
 - The BPA triggers when an infection is documented, but no matching Isolation order is placed for proper precautions.
 - Details in the BPA offer instruction for placing Isolation orders based on infection(s).
