


## Difficult Airway FYI Flag


The **Difficult Airway FYI Flag** will populate as an **FYI Flag icon** and its **own line** on all clinical Storyboards. Follow the steps below to add and remove the Difficult Airway FYI Flag from the Storyboard.

### Adding the Difficult Airway FYI Flag

1. The Difficult Airway FYI Flag will auto-populate on the Storyboard when **one of the following** is documented in the patient's chart:
  - a. An **Intubation Procedure Note** indicating a **Patient had a Difficult Intubation**.
  - b. The Problem List includes **Difficult Airway**.
  - c. A new **Difficult Airway FYI Flag** is added.



## Removing Difficult Airway FYI Flag

To remove the Difficult Airway FYI Flag, it needs to be **Disabled** directly from the Storyboard.

1. From the storyboard, click the Difficult Airway icon.
2. To disable the FYI Flag, select **No** for “Does this patient have a difficult airway?”.
3. Click accept.
4. The Difficult Airway FYI Flag will no longer show on the Storyboard.

**Note:** Resolving the Problem List **will not remove** the Difficult Airway FYI Flag.
