Subject: Post -Therapy Prostate Specific Antigen Screen

- Upstate Pathology is currently offering “**Total Prostate Specific Antigen Screen**” (**Epic Code: LAB2849**) reported only to the tenths digit (to 0.1). Reference Range: 0.0-4.0 ng/mL. This is the test used to evaluate for prostate adenocarcinoma and is the assay which should continue to be ordered for most patients.
- Effective September 11th, 2019, Upstate Pathology will now offer “**Post-Therapy Prostate Specific Antigen Screen**” (**Epic Code: LAB9212**) as an aid in the management of patients following surgery or medical treatment for prostate cancer which is reported up to thousandth digit. Reference range: 0.014–4.000 ng/mL. According to the American Urological Association (AUA), serum PSA should decrease and remain at **undetectable levels** after radical prostatectomy. Thus, we are offering this assay for monitoring these patients.
