- Buprenorphine (Suboxone) is useful for general screening in contexts of compliance and/or abuse. A screen is the preferred initial step for monitoring or ruling out buprenorphine exposure.
- To date, Buprenorphine assay in urine is a send-out test at SUNY Upstate Medical Hospital with a turnaround time of approximately 4 days. Effective November 14th, 2019, Buprenorphine will be performed in-house at the Upstate Pathology lab with 2 hour turnaround time (Epic Code: LAB9220).
- Please remember that this assay is a preliminary screening test. If the specimen screens positive, all positive results are presumptive and unconfirmed.
- If confirmation/quantitation by LC-MS/MS is required, this must be ordered by calling the Upstate core lab at 464-4460 within 5 days of sample collection.
