

# COVID Convalescent Plasma Ordering

- COVID Convalescent Plasma (CCP) is available as a treatment for COVID infections through an Emergency Use Authorization from the FDA.
- CCP is administered as 1 unit for adults (or 10-15 ml/kg for pediatrics) per day, up to a maximum of 3 units over 3 days
- CCP may be ordered through the links on the adult and pediatric COVID admission ordersets (see below)
- A separate order for 1 unit (or appropriate dose for pediatrics) of CCP is required each day that a dose is given
