

# Blood gases & pH reference interval change



#### APPLIES TO ALL INPATIENT LOCATIONS AT BOTH CAMPUSES

- Blood gases and pH testing at Upstate will be transitioned to a new instrument on 11/18/2021.
- Because of this change, the reference values for <u>some</u> of the blood gas analytes need to be updated.
- The analytes listed below have the indicated changes to their reference ranges.
- For any analytes not listed, the reference values remain unchanged.

# The EPIC order codes for all blood gas and pH tests are unchanged

#### Current reference intervals:

# Arterial blood gas

pH 7.38 - 7.44

pCO<sub>2</sub> 35 - 40 mmHg

pO<sub>2</sub> 95 – 100 mmHg

## Venous blood gas

pH 7.36 -7.41

pCO<sub>2</sub>. 40–45 mmHg

pO<sub>2</sub> n/a

#### New reference intervals:

# Arterial blood gas

pH 7.35-7.45 (all ages)

pCO<sub>2</sub> Male 35-48 mmHg (all ages)

Female 32-45 mmHg (all ages)

pO<sub>2</sub> 83-108 mmHg (all ages)

#### Venous blood gas

oH 7.35-7.45 (all ages)

pCO, 40-60 mmHg (all ages)

pO<sub>2</sub> 15-52 mmHg (> 5 yrs)

25-49 mmHg (birth to 5 yrs)
