- **Population and Behavioral Science:** cancer health disparities, social determinants of health, behavioral, and community-based participatory, population-based cancer prevention programs.

The Synergistic Partnership for Enhancing Excellence in Cancer Health (SPEECH) is a NIH/NCI funded regional comprehensive cancer health disparities partnership between Temple University/Fox Chase Cancer Center and Hunter College (TUFCCC/HC). We invite students, post-doctoral fellows, and junior faculty to submit abstracts for poster presentation.
