




Have you considered a Master's in Physiology?



Qualified Norton College of Medicine students can expand their medical education to include a **research** Master's in Physiology.

The Physiology MS program gives students with an interest in research an opportunity to **spend 1 year in one of Upstate's leading-edge laboratories**, working directly with principal investigators and their teams as they work to increase biomedical knowledge.

The Physiology MS is optimized for MD students who want to deepen their understanding of research processes and the impact of research on medicine. Ideal applicants have prior laboratory experience and may want to pursue biomedical research after graduation.

Students apply at the end of their first year of medical school and start the MS after completing the pre-clerkship curriculum and passing the STEP-1 exam. Following their year in the Physiology MS program, students resume their medical education.

Interested students are encouraged to **take part in the summer research program from the Office of Research for Medical Students.** This will provide a realistic understanding for what would be expected of them during their MS studies, as well as an opportunity to identify a potential mentor.
