Spend your summer conducting research at Mass General Brigham through the Center for Academic Development and Enrichment's Office for Engagement and Enrichment.

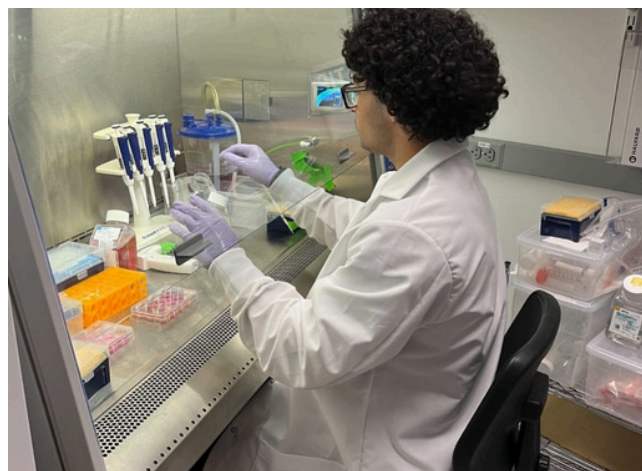

Requirements:

- Interest in academic medicine or biomedical research.
- Undergraduate senior; rising first-year medical student; first-year medical student; graduate student; or post-baccalaureate student.
- U.S. citizen or permanent resident.
- Completed application with personal statement, resume/CV, photo, two letters of recommendation, and all required transcripts.
- Ability to work exclusively at Mass General Brigham for 8 weeks with full availability for the entire duration.
