On January 21, 2021, Upstate University Health System was the first SUNY Health System to achieve Magnet Recognition through the American Nurses Credentialing Center (ANCC). This was an outstanding achievement and recognition. We are on track for Magnet re-designation, which includes submitting a written document filled with 92 stories, data, and graphs demonstrating nursing excellence and improved patient outcomes. This document is due February 3rd, 2025.

Once the ANCC accepts the document, an onsite visit will occur with a team of ANCC Magnet appraisers. We could anticipate a site visit in late fall 2025 or early 2026. The appraisers will visit all areas where nursing is practiced. Upstate Nursing will be excited to showcase all the great work in your areas!!


