### Pediatric After Hours is Moving! 🚚

Effective November 4, Pediatric After Hours will be relocating from Community Campus to the NAPPI Wellness Institute (725 E Adams St), operating within the UPAC space (4th floor). Our hours of operation will remain the same, with patient walk-ins accepted from 4:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m. on weekdays and 12:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. on weekends.

We will continue to provide care for children with lower acuity conditions and perform minor procedures, supported by on-site laboratory and imaging capabilities. Parking will be available in both Garage West and Garage East, with access to the building until 11:00 p.m. Families will also benefit from the convenience of an on-site pharmacy for medication pick-up, open until 11:00 p.m., daily.
